- Most of these pictures produce a standard sound.
- Some sounds change with the addition of vowel marks.

The title block below shows the name of the letter and the picture word it represents.

Name – Picture Represented

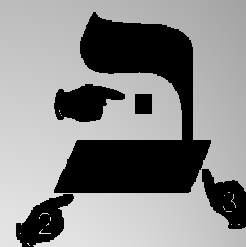


- The finger is pointing to distinguishing marks
- Notice it extends on the top right corner.

ד Dalet - Door

1. The vowel mark changes the sound to B
2. The bottom is strait
3. Notice the extension on the bottom right
